- 2. Election of Officers, 10:05 am.
  - a. Lawrence nominated Verden for President. Second by Borling. Approved unanimously.

- 4. Director's Report by Brehm, 10:15 am.
  - a. Many big shows this spring have been sold-out.

    - ii. We hope to have the Sneak Peak ready for the weekend.
  - g. Brochure ads are being sold
  - h. The Arts Council has taken up Art Walk Stoughton and is scheduled on 9/28/19.

  - j. The gift shop has been going well and the Mayor's office has been helpful for merch.

  - k. The Opera House is in need of a new piano. We're looking at funding options with SOHFA and talking to both the closing Steinway store and Farley's House of Pianos.

  - a. Actual Net Profit is \$109.763 which is higher than projected.
  - b. The Net Loss is \$37,512 before the city subsidy.

  - d. Some good shows recently: Harp Twins, Kottke, O'Brien, Subdudes. Sam Bush had disappointing sales.

  - a. Lewis will be checking into a grant for the piano purchase and looking at fundraising.
  - b. Had the first meeting with Sharon Lezberg to start the Strategic Plan process.
  - c. Another meeting will follow up.
  - d. Catfish planning is coming along.
  - e. Verden is working on sponsorships, reaching out to Madison Essentials and Isthmus for advertising.
