Call to order: Esch called to order @ 5:04 PM

- <u>Communications:</u>
 - *Kemppainen* stated Public Works has a new Parks Supervisor that started this week; Mark.
 - *Esch* announced that she is leaving Stoughton for Iowa soon and resigning from the Tree Commission
 - Point stated he is building hangers for the Arbor Day Art Show
 - Kemppainen stated he will be speaking in Green Bay at the WAA Conference later this month
- <u>Approval of minutes from January 13th, 2022 Meeting:</u> Motion by Point, seconded by Tangeman to approve the minutes. Carried 5-0.
- November Forestry Reports: Kemppainen stated:
 - Winter tree trimming began in January with the city's contractor (Tree Wise Men) 345 medium to large trees were trimmed for a total cost of \$19,143. City crews will work on small trees in the same neighborhoods in February.
 - I assisted with snow removal for multiple storm events in January.
 - The Tree Commission is sponsoring an art fair at the public library in celebration of Arbor Day 2022. Kathy Esch has been spearheading the effort.
 - I will be speaking on Urban Wood Utilization at the upcoming Wisconsin Arborist Association conference in Green Bay on February 22.
 - Spring tree planting planning has begun. I ordered 25 trees for the gravel bed at Public Works for infill trees.
 - The Riverfront Project plans were modified and reviewed again with project designers. I provided input into tree planting for public spaces.
 - No residents were notified of code violations for dead/dying/dangerous trees in January.

OLD BUSINESS: Update on Arbor Day Art show progress:

• *Esch* stated she anticipates up to 78 pieces submitted and Mike will be helping with setup. Kathy and Mike will be setting up a meeting soon to finalize displays.

OLD BUSINESS: Update on Tree Planting Sale:

- *Kemppainen* stated that the trees have been ordered and should be available for pick up in early April. He will pick up them up to avoid delivery charges
- NEW BUSINESS: Elect a new Chair

• With filling a new Chair there will also be a vacancy to fill. *Hundt* is Vice Chair and was absent from the meeting.

Motion by Tangeman, seconded by Short to Table until next month to discuss with Vice Chair. Motion carried 5-0

- Winter tree trimming was completed in February.
- I assisted with snow removal for multiple storm events in February.
- I spoke on Urban Wood Utilization at the Wisconsin Arborist Association conference in Green Bay on February 22.
- Spring tree planting planning continued. I placed an order for 80 trees for spring planting with Weiler Nursery.
- Road construction project planning began in February. I reviewed tree conflicts and began to notify residents of private and public tree removals that will be necessary.
- One resident was notified of code violations for a code violation tree in February. The tree is along a trail near Jackson Street and will be removed by Parks staff in order to improve the walking path by the pond.
